Why install an AccessPack?

Although the national licensing system for persons performing high risk work ensures that license holders are suitably trained and qualified, it does not preclude equipment being operated by persons without a current licence. Furthermore, other machinery may also be hazardous, or severely impact the business, if used inappropriately. Therefore a method of restricting access to authorised users is required for critical or high risk equipment.

AccessPack is an access control system that can be fitted to any electrically powered device, but is particularly well suited to stand-alone, mobile or remote plant. AccessPack uses smart card technology to ensure that equipment can only be used by authorised personnel. Users are automatically logged off when the equipment is stationary, idle or stopped. To ensure accountability, AccessPack records who accessed the equipment and when.
